#### **SUMMARY:**

### **PURPOSE OF REQUEST:**

Tyler Technologies is our provider of the Brazos E-Citation software and devices that allows officers to automate the citation process in the field. The E-Citation software allows the Police Officers to scan driver licenses and vehicle registrations to obtain more accurate offender information. In addition, the citation information is automatically uploaded into the court software which bypasses the possibility of clerical errors. This proposed purchase includes 15 new and 39 replacement handheld devices, chargers, printers, paper, cables, batteries, and software required to interface with the City's existing system.

Chapter 271.102 of the Local Government Code authorizes local governments to participate in a cooperative purchasing program with another local government or local cooperative organization. In lieu of competitive bidding, items and services may be purchased through such agreements as the agreements have already been bid by the sponsoring entity or agency. The City of Grand Prairie has master inter-local cooperative agreements with various entities including Sourcewell.
