PURPOSE OF REQUEST:

The annual contract is for maintenance and repair services of the SCADA system. This service includes, but not limited to, instrumentation maintenance, services upgrades, calibration, troubleshooting, and repairs. The SCADA system monitors the flow of meters, totalizers, level recorders, pressure recorders and switches, remote telemetry units and their components, tone transmitters and receivers, and lift stations and their components. This contract will also be for scheduled work, including quarterly calibration of instruments and general operation monitoring.

Notice of Bid #25045 was advertised in the Fort Worth Star Telegram and Planet Bids; it was distributed to 109 vendors including 5 Grand Prairie vendors and 61 HUBS/MWBEs. 2 bids were received.

Staff wishes to award the primary contract to Prime Controls, L.P. and the secondary contract to Super Tech Automation, LLC dba Supertech Automation.
