PURPOSE OF REQUEST:

In late 2020, a comprehensive plan update for the southern sector of the City (Southgate 360 Corridor Plan) was completed to prepare for the expansive growth in our southern sector. The update encompassed the area south of Ragland Road to the southern limits of the City extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ). The City is now continuing this effort north as Phase 2 of the comprehensive plan update. Phase 2 will encompass the City area north of Ragland Road up to the Pioneer Parkway corridor. The subject study area is generally bounded by SH 360 to the west, SH 303/Pioneer Parkway to the north, the eastern city limits to the east, and Joe Pool Lake and adjacent lands to the south.

This project will review and provide recommendations related to housing, land use, mobility, sustainability and resilience, economic development and other topics in order to prepare the City for the future. The Future Land Use Map, a guide used for proposed future development intent for properties,

will be updated as part of this project to address development goals and any land use conflicts with existing development and zoning.

The proposed costs are set forth in the table below. Total costs include subconsultant costs. Once approved to proceed, the anticipated time for completion of the update will be 10-12 months.
