**TITLE:** Ordinance amending Schedule III of the Traffic Register by modifying effective times at a school zone on Robinson Road near Pinebrook Drive and modifying school zone limits for four zones on Claremont Drive, Corn Valley Road, Freetown Road, and Robinson Road to cover additional crossing patterns

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Approve

**ANALYSIS:**

The school zone on Robinson Road near Pinebrook Drive was initially created to cover pedestrians crossing for bus pick-up and drop-off for various schools. However, students from a nearby elementary school have been using this zone, as well. In order to provide coverage for all students using this school zone, the effective times must be extended.

Four school zones are being extended to cover additional areas where kids are crossing. One is for Starrett Elementary School on Claremont Drive. One extends the zone for South Grand Prairie High School on Corn Valley Road. Two zones for Advantage Academy are being extended to cover students crossing to the Boys and Girls Club on Freetown Road and on Robinson Road.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION:**

All costs associated with these school zone adjustments in the field will be paid out of the annual operating budget.

**BODY**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND PRAIRIE, TEXAS, AMENDING SCHEDULE III OF THE TRAFFIC REGISTER TO ESTABLISH MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS LESS THAN 30 MPH; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND PRAIRIE, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** THAT Schedule III – Establish Maximum Speed Limits less than 30 mph shall be amended as follows:
