TITLE: Amendment to existing contract with Axon Enterprise, Inc., through a cooperative agreement with Sourcewell, to upgrade and remove certain equipment resulting in a reduction of \$868,829 for the current term, \$152,560 in each of the currently authorized five optional renewal terms, and to add one additional one-year optional renewal term in the amount of \$1,460,319.55 for a total contract reduction, if all renewals are exercised, in the amount of \$171,309.45

SUMMARY:

PURPOSE OF REQUEST:

In 2021, City Council approved a ten-year agreement with Axon, Inc., to supply the Police Department with body cameras, in-car cameras, Tasers, Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) software platform, and numerous other products and services.

Recently, Axon ended development and sales of their CAD software. The Police Department had not yet implemented the CAD software, and expended no funds on the CAD software. As consideration for the inconvenience of ending development of the CAD software, Axon has agreed to provide the Police Department with numerous hardware and software services at little to no cost to the City. The most significant component of this consideration is AI-assisted translation services. This product, Axon Assistant, will provide all body camera users with the ability to translate over 50 languages in real time. This feature will greatly improve our service to the public and will greatly reduce the need for a third-party translation service.

The net financial impact of the proposed contractual changes is a savings of \$868,829 in the current contract term, and a savings of \$152,560 in future contract terms, totaling a savings of \$1,631,629. The

total of the savings is consistent with the amounts originally contracted and budgeted for the former CAD software platform.

The Police, Fire, and Information Technology Departments are working together on an upgrade to the current CAD software platform. Preliminary cost estimates closely match the amount of the savings of the proposed Axon contract amendment and will allow for an upgrade with no budget impact.

Additionally, the Police Department is seeking approval to extend the agreement by one optional one-year renewal term, at the same pricing and terms as the original 2021 agreement, \$1,460,319.55. Even with the additional year of service, the proposed amendment would result in a net reduction of \$171,309.45 if all renewals are exercised.
