PURPOSE OF REQUEST:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requires the City of Grand Prairie to complete field verification of all storm drainage outfalls within a five-year cycle as part of its Minimum Control Measures (MCM) program to prevent harmful discharges into the public waters.

This contract provides for the inspection and inventory of storm drainage outfalls located within the City's next inspection section, which includes 321 storm drainage outfalls. The scope of work includes documenting each outfall with detailed photographs; evaluating structural integrity, erosion, and sedimentation conditions; observing and recording any potential environmentally hazardous discharges; and notifying the City of any conditions requiring immediate attention to protect the storm drainage system and stormwater quality.

The study is anticipated to begin in March 2026 and is expected to be completed by September 2026.
