#### **SUMMARY**:

#### **<u>PURPOSE OF REQUEST</u>**:

This contract with Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc (CTC) will be utilized for the purchase of Traffic Control and traffic signal equipment on an as-needed basis. This includes, but is not limited to, traffic signal (Opticom) equipment, traffic signal heads, traffic signal pedestrian push buttons, and school zone flasher equipment. This equipment is required to maintain and repair the traffic signals and school flashers installed within the City of Grand Prairie.

Section 271.102 of the Local Government Code authorizes local governments to participate in a cooperative purchasing program with another local government or local cooperative organization. In lieu of competitive bidding, items, and services may be purchased through such agreements as the agreements have already been bid by the sponsoring entity or agency. The City of Grand Prairie has master cooperative agreements with various entities, including HGAC.

HGAC primarily offers products that are utilized in the fields of Public Safety, Public Works, and Communications. A wide variety of capital equipment is under contract, and through a unique feature of HGAC Buy equipment can be customized through the use of published and unpublished options to fit agencies' specifications and requirements.

The proposed Contract with CTC will expire on April 30, 2026. At that time, City staff will propose a new contract.
