PURPOSE OF REQUEST:

Since 2011, the United States Marshals Service (USMS) Northern District of Texas has used space and services at the Public Safety Building and other Police Department facilities to operate their North Texas Fugitive Task Force (NTFTF). The existing MOU has resulted in numerous joint arrests and cooperation in Grand Prairie and other parts of the metroplex, which has improved public safety in the region.

The existing MOU is expiring, and both the USMS and Police Department have expressed interest in continuing the access and use arrangement. The proposed MOU will be for an initial term of three years, with the option to extend the MOU for three additional one-year periods. The USMS will remit quarterly payments to the city at a rate of \$37,812.50 (\$151,250 per year). This represents a 10% increase over the current MOU's rate.
