PURPOSE OF REQUEST:

This contract would provide aerial LiDAR data covering the City of Grand Prairie, a total area of approximately 100 square miles. This data is utilized for stormwater drainage checks, levee elevation verification, and uses related to stormwater drainage infrastructure modeling. This data is vital in ensuring the City's current infrastructure is safe and efficient with stormwater drainage, as well as identifying potential improvements/additions that can be made to this infrastructure.

Chapter 271.102 of the Local Government Code authorizes local governments to participate in a cooperative purchasing program with another local government or local cooperative organization. In lieu of competitive bidding, items and services may be purchased through such agreements as the agreements have already been bid by the sponsoring entity or agency. The City of Grand Prairie has interlocal cooperative agreements with various entities, including Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR). DIR has awarded Contract #DIR-CPO-4498 to The Sanborn Map Company, Inc.
