PURPOSE OF REQUEST:

This annual contract will be used by General Services - Fleet Services for maintenance and repairs on City owned fire apparatuses.

Annual contract cost *up to* \$50,000 takes into account increased non-warranty maintenance costs associated with continued use of units. Additionally, this allows for any unexpected, single major repair that may be needed and which may exceed previous years' spending. For example, replacement of a hydraulic pump on a ladder truck can cost up to \$10,000. While we hope to keep expenditures low as the experience demonstrates, having the available annual amount up to \$50,000 allows us to make any emergency repair needed to get emergency equipment back in service expeditiously for our customers.

Buyboard awarded Siddons Martin Emergency Group, LLC contract number 746-24 to provide Fire Service Apparatus Vehicles. The current term of the cooperative contract started on October 1, 2024, and terminates September 30, 2025.

State Purchasing laws, Government Code, Chapter 271.102 authorize local governments to enter into cooperative agreements for the performance of governmental functions normally associated with the operation of government such as purchasing necessary materials and supplies. The City of Grand Prairie has master cooperative agreements with various entities, including Buyboard.
