## **BACKGROUND:**

Before being hired back to the City of Grand Rapids as full time Fire Chief, I (Travis Cole) was employed with the State of MN as a Deputy State Fire Marshal on the Residential Care and Lodging team. Our primary job task was inspecting all Board and lodging establishments (hotels/motels) with 6 or more guest rooms throughout the state. I covered 9 counties in the NE part of MN. Minnesota statutes require these facilities to be inspected once, every 3 years with a fee applying to all establishments with 35 or more guest rooms. At the June 8, 2020, council meeting, City Council authorized entering into a Joint Powers Agreement with the State of MN to conduct all hotel inspections with our Governmental Units jurisdiction in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 299F.46 and to assure uniform enforcement throughout the State of Minnesota. This agreement was for 3 years and must now be renewed. The new JPA will be effective from January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023, with an expiration date of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
