### Impact of Legionella and Chlorination (Thru June 30, 2024)

• Financial Impact:

➤ Operations Cost: \$259,167

➤ Capital Expenditure: \$379,263

➤Total: \$638,430





#### **Operating Reserve Policy**



- ➤ Accumulated Operating Reserve target of 50% for each utility
- ➤50% target calculated on previous year's audited annual expenses
- ➤ Amounts over 50% transfer to Asset Replacement account



> Fall below 50% target present plan to meet 50% operating reserve





#### **ERP Collaboration with the City**

- Project Benefits
  - Same chart of accounts Tall Timber Days
  - Cross training
  - Financial roll-up
  - Capital asset planning
  - Interfund (City and PU) and Intrafund (PU utilities) efficiencies





- Future Collaborative efforts once ERP is operational is Asset Management
