A \$5,333 DONATION FROM THE CITY OF COHASSET and  
A \$3,000 DONATION FROM THE GREATER POKEGAMA LAKE ASSOCIATION FOR

WHEREAS, Minnesota State Statutes 465.03, states that cities may accept gifts of real or personal property, including money, and use them in accordance with the terms the donor prescribes; and
