You will be required to submit a progress report of expenditures by April 1st, 2025. This will ensure that all funds will be expended by September 30th, 2025 and any amendments can be made to your grant agreement if you will not be using funds allocated.

This is a reimbursement program, and the funds will be disbursed upon receipt of the signed, completed forms, along with the proper supporting documentation (by October 31st, 2025).
