Requirements to Volunteer

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- *Should a minimum hour requirement be made of volunteers?*

Roles and Responsibilities

- Volunteers for the Human Rights Commission are expected to act in a professional manner as they are representing the city of Grand Rapids
- Interactions with the public should be professional and kind
- Various tasks could be assigned to volunteers such as tabling or assisting with events these include but not limited to the Itasca County Fair, Tall Timber Days, Juneteenth Celebration, and Indigenous People's Day Celebration
- Volunteers are asked to sign an agreement with Grand Rapid's Human Rights Commission that their work is completely voluntary and they do not expect to receive payment for their time

Recruitment of Volunteers

- Volunteers can be recruited through other community organizations (such as but not limited to Elder Circle Volunteer Program, social media, and community members attending open HR Commission Meetings)
