Will:

I just finished a meeting with our Bookmobile crew where we reviewed the proposed schedule for 2023. We are dropping a couple of Itasca County stops due to non-use by patrons. With some gaps to fill, we are considering adding Warba. We could also use a second stop in that same part of Itasca County. As you know only too well, that's the so-called Grand Rapids Library "service area." I plan to recommend to the ALS Board that for the purpose of Bookmobile stops, ALS should move ahead with extending service to some locations. Any strong objections? Any suggestions for locating a second stop down there? One of the stops we are dropping is Taconite. We had suspended stops in Swan River and Trout Lake during the start of the pandemic, and we don't plan to restore either of those.
