A <u>protected class</u> refers to certain groups of individuals protected by anti-discrimination laws, such as women, older workers, people with disabilities, minorities and others.

The State of Minnesota recognizes 11 protected classes:

Race - Color - Creed - Religion National Origin - Sex - Marital Status Sexual Orientation - Disability - Age Status with regard to public assistance
