





Thornton Tomasetti Structural Design Work Example

MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MEMORIAL

Washington, DC

Thornton Tomasetti provided structural engineering for a new memorial that occupies a four-acre site along the tidal basin on the National Mall.

A crescent-shaped plaza is surrounded by curving, stone-clad retaining walls carved with inscriptions. Two large stones, the "mountains of despair," form a gateway flanked by waterfalls. On the plaza, the "stone of hope" incorporates a 31-foot-tall sculpture of Reverend King. Thornton Tomasetti's engineers worked closely with the geotechnical consultant to overcome extremely challenging soil conditions. The entire memorial rests upon piles driven to bedrock.

The water features posed an additional design challenge. Plans originally called for a remote pump-room with underground piping running to the falls. A design change added below-grade pump rooms beneath each of the waterfalls, with a 175-foot tunnel providing access to both. This required the tunnel to run directly below the massive "mountains of despair." Thornton Tomasetti reanalyzed and reconfigured the arrangement of piles supporting the stones to accommodate the tunnel. The design of the tunnel itself was complex, requiring precise integration with many different components. Highly detailed and coordinated drawings ensured that the design intent was clear and simplified construction.

The project includes a 3,000-square-foot structure across the street from the memorial. The building, which features a 12-foot roof cantilever, houses a bookstore and ranger station with public facilities.





Structural engineering for the “New Man” sculpture installation located in a high Grand Stair space within a 75,000-square-foot sanctuary of worship. The 38-foot-tall sculpture features the body of a man wrapped in a spiral of vining branches with butterflies.

This unique sculpture presented several structural challenges. With many large and long holes throughout the piece, stress on the bronze was concentrated and created local buckling concerns. A peer review was performed for another engineer’s design of the statue where the bronze thickness was increased to one inch in some places, creating greater strength demands. However, due to the limitations of the fabricator, the bronze could only be 3/8 inches thick. To work within the fabricator parameters and preserve the sculpture’s form, friction pendulum isolators were used to reduce bronze thickness enough to facilitate fabrication of the sculpture. The use of base isolation substantially improved the seismic performance of the piece, providing for a long design life. Analysis was performed using several programs, including NASTRAN.

We also provided structural engineering for the sanctuary which includes 13 domes, the largest of which is eighty feet in diameter. The sanctuary, foyers, library and classroom are above grade and total 19,000 square feet. The concourse level is entirely underground and includes a plaza, rotunda, offices, bookstore, kitchen, studio and other support spaces.

As engineer of record, our façade engineering and forensics groups also provided technical consultation to architects for design and specification of Carrara marble cladding and plaza paving system, in connection with development of the 66,000-square-foot sanctuary and gardens.




WORLD EXPO 2020 CENTERPIECE VENUE

Dubai, United Arab Emirates

The first World Expo held in the region, Expo 2020 Dubai will host 190 participating countries and visitors. The full project is composed of two hotel buildings, three office towers and a central basement. As the crown jewel and centerpiece of the Expo masterplan, the Al Wasl Plaza features a dramatic 70-meter tall, 150 diameter gridshell design at its heart, referred to as the "Trellis."

Thornton Tomasetti provided structural design services to the architects, collaborating closely to develop a structural system that met the stringent aesthetic requirements and was optimized for constructability.

Unlike traditional diagonalized gridshells, the unique structural framework of the "Trellis" draws inspiration from the event's iconographic logo as a series of nested and tangent rings that result in a flexurally governed ductile structural system. Each of the steel rings are in-filled with Polytetrafluoroethylene (PTFE) fabric panels that function both as shading for the open plaza and a projection surface for dramatic 360 degree immersive events for Expo attendees and future visitors. Key structural engineering considerations were related to the geometric definition, loading and performance criteria, global stability and imperfections, and the steel fabrication and erection.

Thornton Tomasetti also provided structural engineering services for the hotel and commercial buildings around the plaza. Each of the five structures dramatically cantilever towards the "Trellis" surface, giving occupants dramatic and unique views of the landscaped plaza and projected immersive experience.

The San Diego Zoo's origin myth starts with a lion. After hearing a lion's roar amongst the caged animals left over from the 1915-16 Panama-California Exposition's exotic animals exhibition in Balboa Park, Dr. Harry Wegeforth felt inspired and subsequently founded the world-famous zoo. More than a hundred years later, this story has been immortalized with "Rex's Roar," the world's largest cantilever bronze animal statue. Thornton Tomasetti provided structural engineering services for the sculpture's structural steel skeleton and concrete foundation.

At more than 27 feet tall and weighing in excess of 18,000 pounds, Rex's Roar had to be securely positioned for the safety of patrons and zoo visitors. Numerous scale models were scanned and modeled from the original illustration before the final sculpture was created out of 200 bronze pieces welded together. The pieces were first 3D printed to create hollow ceramic-coated wax molds to cast the bronze. The lion was bolted to an 8,000-pound stainless steel skeleton consisting of a supportive spine and ribs, then anchored by a 100,000-pound concrete footing.

Besides the weight and size of the sculpture, San Diego is a highly seismic area, which presented additional challenges. The large bronze sculpture had to withstand large seismic vertical forces and torques, but no off-the-shelf piece of stainless steel of the right strength, stiffness and size fit inside Rex's leg. To solve the problem, a custom heavy tube welded from individual plates was used. Many connections between the stainless steel and bronze helped distribute the load and avoid

over-stressing the 3/16-inch-thick bronze. Additionally, the clip angle connections between the bronze and steel were checked for stresses resulting from differential thermal expansion to ensure that hot days wouldn't affect the structural stability of the sculpture.



GOOGLE BAY VIEW CAMPUS

Mountain View, California

Our innovative approach to the roof design and construction sequencing ensured this corporate headquarters stayed on schedule.

Located in a high-seismic zone, Google's Mountain View corporate campus includes three distinct buildings that feature expressive sweeping canopy roof structures. The canopies are shallow inverted shell structures - which do not achieve their full stiffness until fully erected - which presented challenges to the fast-track schedule. The unconventional canopy structures also required an innovative design approach.

We provided structural design services to BIG, Heatherwick Studio & Adamson Associates and construction engineering services to Whiting-Turner and Schuff for the three-building campus.

Here's how

We worked closely with the entire project team - including client, architects, construction manager and subcontractors - to develop an architecturally expressive roof that is a structurally efficient system and could be quickly, accurately and efficiently built. Performance-Based Seismic Design employing state of the art analysis techniques was used to demonstrate that the structure exceeds code requirements and satisfied the rigors of peer review during permitting whilst maintaining schedule.

Since the roof is effectively a series of large inverted shells it was not feasible to crane the panels into place in one piece. We collaborated with the steel fabricator early in the process and optimized the design to suit the fabricators' workflow, which involved assembling the roof panels on bolsters at low level and strand-jacking them into place. This design proved much more effective than craning sub-assemblies of the canopy into place in their final location. We also provided erection engineering services to the fabricator to devise the jacking methodology and design the shoring, bolsters, temporary jacking anchorages and sliders.

The result

Erecting the roof canopy steelwork at low level and strand-jacking into place proved much more effective than craning elements of the canopy into place in their final location. Careful planning and rigorous attention to detail ensured that the pieces went together quickly on site while meeting steel tolerances.

The biggest single-hoisted assemblies included more than 180,000 square feet of roof structure covering a footprint of nearly 500 feet by 500 feet at its widest spot, setting a western hemisphere record for the largest roof lift by size and number of strand-jacks used at one time.




FLOTSAM & JETSAM

Miami, Florida

A large-scale installation designed by SHoP Architects for the 2016 Design Miami exhibition, "Flotsam & Jetsam" received the 2016 Panerai Design Miami Visionary Award and garnered acclaim for breaking the Guinness record as the world's largest 3D-printed object. The installation served as the gateway to Design Miami 2016 and was later reconstructed as a semi-permanent installation at the Miami Design District's "Jungle Plaza."

Branch Technology produced most of the structure using its patented free-form cellular fabrication technique to print a special mix of chopped carbon fiber and ABS plastic. Oak Ridge National Laboratory printed a portion of the installation using polypropylene reinforced with bamboo fibers.

Thornton Tomasetti's CORE studio engineered the pavilions that composed the structure and, in the process, invented new analysis techniques to quickly evaluate versions of the complex conformal lattice. An effective anisotropic shell-stiffness matrix was found to represent the overall lattice behavior accurately to within 0.1 percent, performing 20 times faster than the complete lattice model. Quick feedback was especially crucial for supporting design decisions to meet production goals.



BROOKFIELD PLACE ENTRY PAVILION

New York, New York

The Brookfield Place Entry Pavilion is the gateway connecting the underground pedestrian passageway from the surrounding transportation hubs to the waterfront retail complex at the renovated World Financial Center.

The new entrance was conceived as a clear glass box with minimal structural supports. As the lead structural engineer for the project, Thornton Tomasetti designed the two 53-foot sculptural steel columns along with the remainder of the steel and concrete superstructure to support the 8,000-square-foot space.

Here's how

The shape of the columns and their placement within the pavilion were influenced by complex site constraints. Located above the new passageway tunnel, an existing train tunnel relieving platform and a former pedestrian bridge pile cap, the supports for the entire structure had to be focused to only two points of contact underground. The site constraints guided the design team toward the idea of two funnel-shaped columns that grow from small footprints at the foundation to support the large roof. The architect's vision for the sculptural columns consisted of continuous pipes woven together in a basket-like fashion. Thornton Tomasetti collaborated closely with the architect and the steel contractor to develop connection details with a seamless finished appearance.
