A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A \$43,500.00 GRANT FROM THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY/OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY FOR A TOWARDS ZERO DEATH GRANT FOR THE GRAND RAPIDS POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Minnesota State Statutes 465.03, states that cities may accept gifts of real or personal property, including money, and use them in accordance with the terms the donor prescribes; and

WHEREAS, every such acceptance shall be by resolution of the governing body adopted by two-thirds majority of its members,
