A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A \$5,266 DONATION FROM HARRIS TOWNSHIP,
A \$5,266 DONATION FROM THE CITY OF COHASSET,
A \$3,660 DONATION FROM THE GREATER POKEGAMA LAKE ASSOCIATION AND
A \$1,000 FROM THE BLANDIN FOUNDATION FOR THE
INDEPENDENCE DAY FIREWORKS AT POKEGAMA LAKE
TO BE HELD JULY 3, 2022

WHEREAS, Minnesota State Statutes 465.03, states that cities may accept gifts of real or personal property, including money, and use them in accordance with the terms the donor prescribes; and

WHEREAS, every such acceptance shall be by resolution of the governing body adopted by two-thirds majority of its members,
