AGENDA ITEM: Consider approving resolutions adopting the 2024 Tax Levy Payable 2025,

2025 General Fund Budgets, 2025 Special Revenue Budgets and 2025

Enterprise Budgets.

BACKGROUND:

The City Council and staff have been working on the 2026 budgets since early 2025. The proposed 2025 Levy, Payable 2026, will result in the exact Net Levy for Payable 2025 (No increase to tax payers as a whole). To achieve this, staff is recommending the use of General Fund cash in an amount of \$118,566 along with \$987,484 in cuts from the 2026 budget as follows:

- 2026 Enterprise Fund Budgets for Pokegama Golf Course and Storm Water Utility Fund.
