<u>Background Information</u>: Pursuant to Government Code Section 37350, the city may declare items as surplus. The City of Grass Valley Fire Department has 16 Motorola APX 6000 handheld radios along with batteries and miscellaneous accessories to surplus and sell. The Fire Department has agencies interested in the purchase of surplus equipment. When sold the proceeds, projected to be between \$20,000.00 and \$35,000.00, will return to the Measure E fund from where the expenditures were made in 2017. The Fire Department also has 34 Scott NXG2 Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBAs) that exceed the 15-year service life for use in the Fire Service. Having little to no value due to the service life maximum, upon surplus the SCBAs will be donated to Sierra College Fire Academy for use in the Academy to train the next generation of firefighters. Resolution 2024-005 reflects the sale of Motorola Radios; Resolution 2024-006 reflects the donation of Self Contained Breathing Apparatus to the Sierra College Fire Academy. A list of the equipment is attached for reference.

<u>Council Goals/Objectives</u>: The execution of this Resolution achieves Strategic Goal #5-High Performance Government and Quality Services.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: Revenues generated by sales will offset future equipment purchases by the City.
