- **Make it easier to escape in an emergency:** Improve the egress and ingress from North Church Street through where Doris Drive enters the Cypress Hills Subdivision above our neighborhood. Specifically, gravel and maintain the upper portion of Doris Drive where no maintenance now occurs. The city needs to maintain the condition of that as a gravel road such that regular cars can easily use it in the event of an emergency evacuation.
- **Slow cars down & improve safety signage:** Create traffic calming/slowing infrastructure such as improved signage around the blind corner where Doris Drive heads up hill and reflective mirrors on either side of that blind corner so oncoming traffic can see around the corner and speed tables on Doris Drive

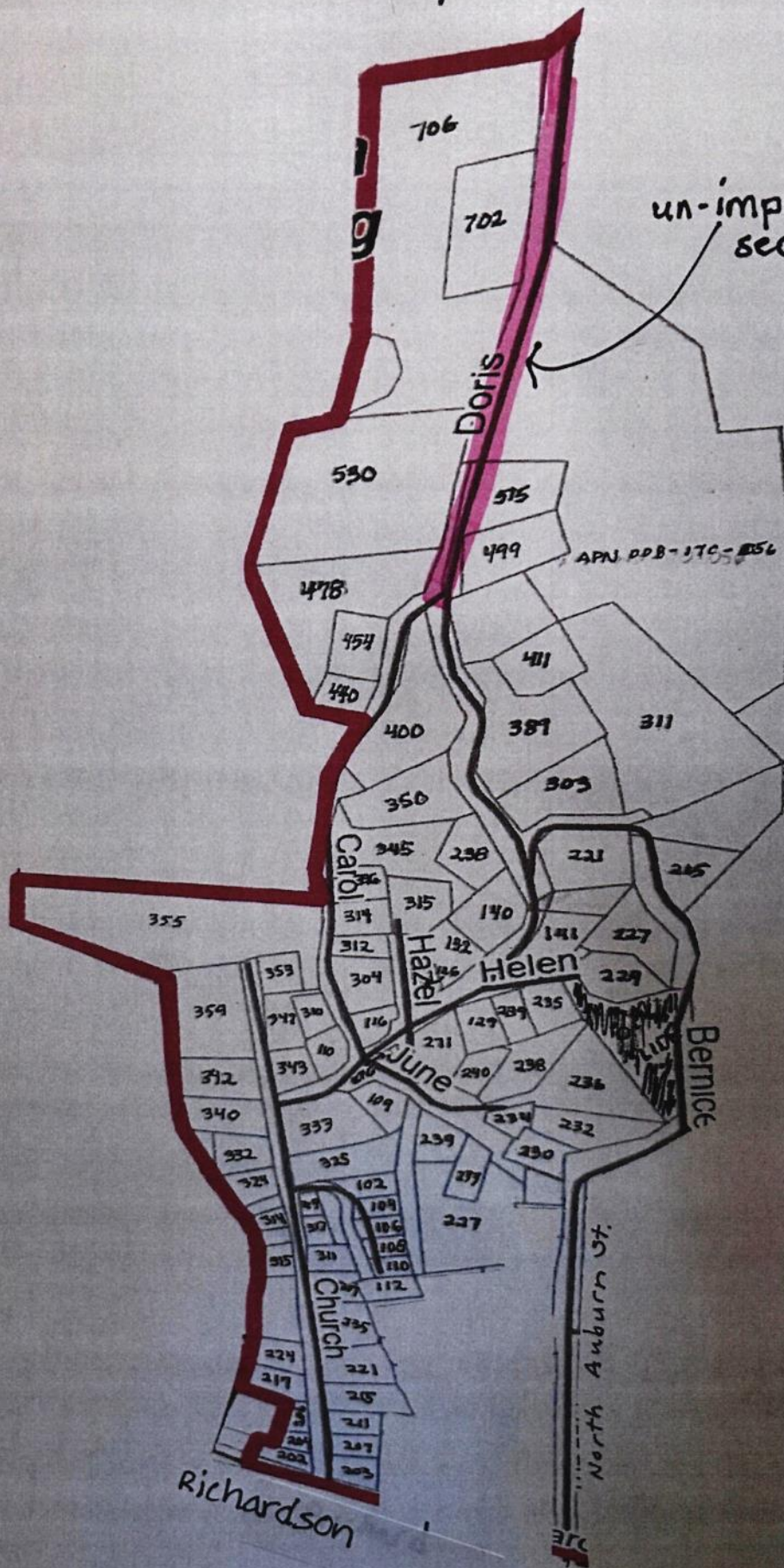
We will present the signatures on petitions that we have gathered from the neighborhood and ask the Council for their support to save our lives.

DORIS DRIVE COMMUNITY SURVEY

This survey is intended to learn about the safety concerns, needs and interests of the residents of the Doris Drive/Slide Creek Ravine neighborhood. We are residents of the community working as volunteers collecting information that we can use to persuade Grass Valley City officials to enact needed changes, such as improvements to ingress and egress, as well as improving traffic safety.

We are part of the newly enlarged Washington Hill Fire Safe Coalition, which brings our residents lots of important benefits. These benefits include access to fire safe information and land management tools such as weed whackers and leaf blowers. We collect information from residents about their community fire safe activities – such as putting on a new roof, brushing a wooded area, or putting up fire resistance fencing – and use that to prove that we are working to reduce our fire risk. Residents that are part of the Coalition can receive an “insurance certificate” that may reduce your insurance fee. To access these benefits, we need your email address (separate from the petition).

Questions:

1. Can you describe your fire safe activities, either recently completed or planned for this year?
2. Can you document any fire safety expenses that you have incurred or plan to incur in the next year?
3. Do you need help with fire safe brushing activities?
4. Will you need special assistance in an emergency evacuation?
5. Are you concerned about ingress and egress in this neighborhood? Would you be willing to sign a petition asking the City to improve traffic and safety in our neighborhood?
6. Would you be willing to participate in a work day in the neighborhood?
7. Do you have any questions?

We will record these answers response sheets that include the address and names of the people that are surveyed. This information will be compiled for use in proving that our residents have met the thresholds of time volunteered and money spent to qualify for the insurance certificate. It will also be used to identify volunteers who will help with work, as well as folks that will need our help.

Survey Questions (one per household)

1. Describe your fire safe activities, either recently completed or planned
2. Have you, or do you plan to spend \$ on fire safety expenses? How much?
3. Do you need help with fire safe brushing activities?
4. Will you need special assistance in an emergency evacuation?
5. Are you worried about roads in this neighborhood? (sign petition)
6. Would you participate in a work day in the neighborhood?
7. Do you have any questions?









