<u>Background Information</u>: The Public Works Department (DPW) is constantly looking for better ways to serve the City and to improve the City's response to Public Works issues. Over the last few months, Public Works staff has been evaluating our response to sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) events and the City's Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP). As part of this review, the City consultant Larry Walker Associates reviewed the City's existing SSMP and updated it to ensure the City is complying with all of the regulations set by the State and Regional Water Resources Control Boards. Our consultant also revised the document to reflect current industry best practices. The SSMP covers information regarding the management of the City's sewer system. This information includes procedures and protocols for daily operation and maintenance, as well as emergency response. The State Water Resources Control Board requires the City to maintain an updated the SSMP. Attached for Council consideration is a copy of the updated Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP).

<u>Council Goals/Objectives</u>: This action promotes the goals of Public Safety and Water and Wastewater Systems and Underground Infrastructure.
