

NARROW GAUGE TRESTLE ABUTMENT

These stone abutments for one of the Nevada County Narrow Gauge Railroad trestles crossing Wolf Creek is one of the few remaining trestle abutments for the Railroad. Originally built of wood in February 1876, it was upgraded in 1885 to the hand crafted granite abutment you see by a Chinese construction crew. It remained in use until the railroad ceased operating in 1942.
