

- Variant tracking in Colorado 53 COVID-19 variant cases (UK B.1.1.7 and CALIFORNIA L452R) -
- <u>37 Variants of concern</u> a variant that may spread easier, cause more severe disease, reduce the effectiveness of treatments or vaccine, or is harder to detect using current tests
- 16 Variants under investigation variants with different characteristics of the original virus, but not yet considered a variant of concern


