

At each Council Meeting, we recognize the people, organizations and businesses that make Greeley Great.





The 2020 on-time graduation rate of 82 percent is an increase from 81.7 in 2019 and a significant increase over the 2017 graduation rate of 78.7. The state average for 2020 is 81.9 percent.
