

in some areas where we have washout near the river. The presentation is April 10th at 1:30pm at City Hall for anyone who is interested in attending.

- In 2016, we asked a question in the PTOL process to see if people would be willing to support financially for more open space and natural areas, and the indication was yes, they would. In 2017, we polled the community and asked if people would be willing to support a new tax for open space and there was a majority of people who would support that. There is currently some citizen momentum to move forward with recommending a sales tax to the voters, but a citizen initiative can not be put on the ballot for a sales tax, only the City Council can put something on the ballot. Andy will meet with the Mayor next week to go over the information.

7. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Naming Recommendations for the park at Trails at Sheep Draw: Rick Reeser suggested the Board narrow the list of potential names to 2 or 3 to vote on. Nominations included Hazelton Park, Journey View, Clearview, Angew Park, and Hazelton Angew Park. Board members were asking to vote for two of the five suggested names. Voting was as follows:

- Hazelton – 8
- Angew - 1
- Hazelton Angew - 0
- Journey View – 3
- Clearview – 1

Caitlin Alexander suggested as the park is developed that we include some history of Hazelton and some of the quotes. A motion was made by Clint Torczon to approve and recommend to City Council, Hazelton Park as the name for the new park. The motion was seconded by Mikyla Silva; motion passed 8-0. Board members thanked Clint for his research and information provided on suggested names.

8. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Review of Bittersweet Irrigation/Re-vegetation Project: Eric Bloomer distributed handouts showing a map of Bittersweet Park and a before/after look of the new native grass area. Eric described the project and displayed the design presentation boards. The project is slated to be completed by mid-summer to open the park back up by early fall.

- B. Tour of Museum “back stage”: Board members were invited to a guided tour of the Museum.
