Rick Reeser noted that the general consensus at the three public meetings was the name "3rd Street Plaza". The location is designed to be a plaza style skate park. Skaters of all ages attended the meetings as well as parents and grandparents of skaters. The attendees were very engaged with the whole process. The only name nominated by the Board was 3rd Street Plaza. A motion was made by Clint Torczon to recommend 3rd Street Plaza as the name. The motion was seconded by Caitlin Alexander and passed 8-0.
