



## Immediate Actions



Safe & Secure Community



- Increase security presence in downtown
- Collaborate with partners to increase surveillance
- Work with judicial system on mandatory jail sentences for repeat offenders
- Team with parole to monitor and work with transient parolees
- Provide liquor store education on habitual offenders and re-education of liquor laws

## Mental Health & Homelessness

- Partnered with North Range Behavioral Health to provide two additional coresponders
- Increased availability of co-responders to respond to calls involving mental health




Co-responders can follow up with citizens suffering mental health issues to both reduce the number of 911 calls and risk of injury to citizens and officers
