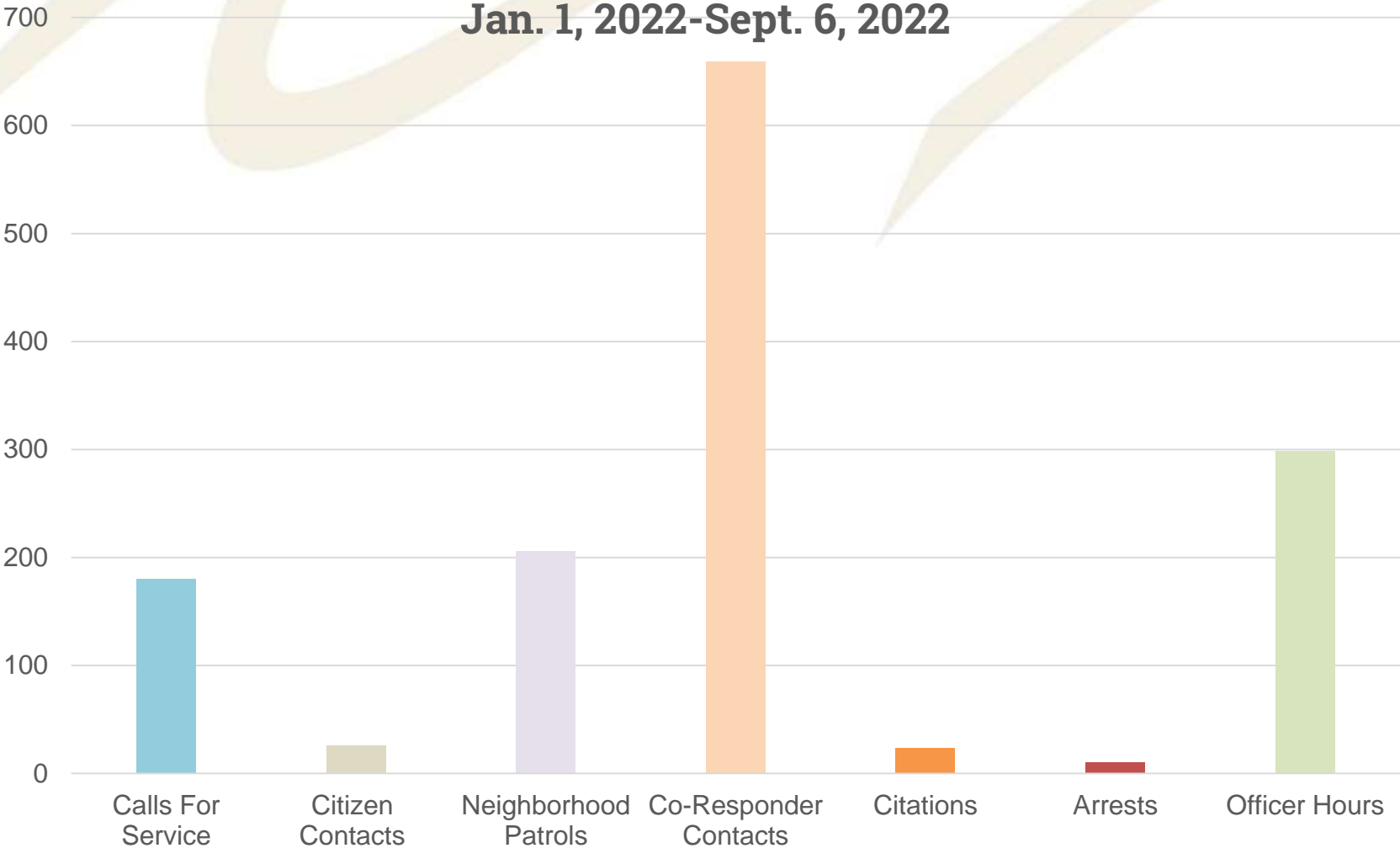

- **GPD responds to all calls for service**

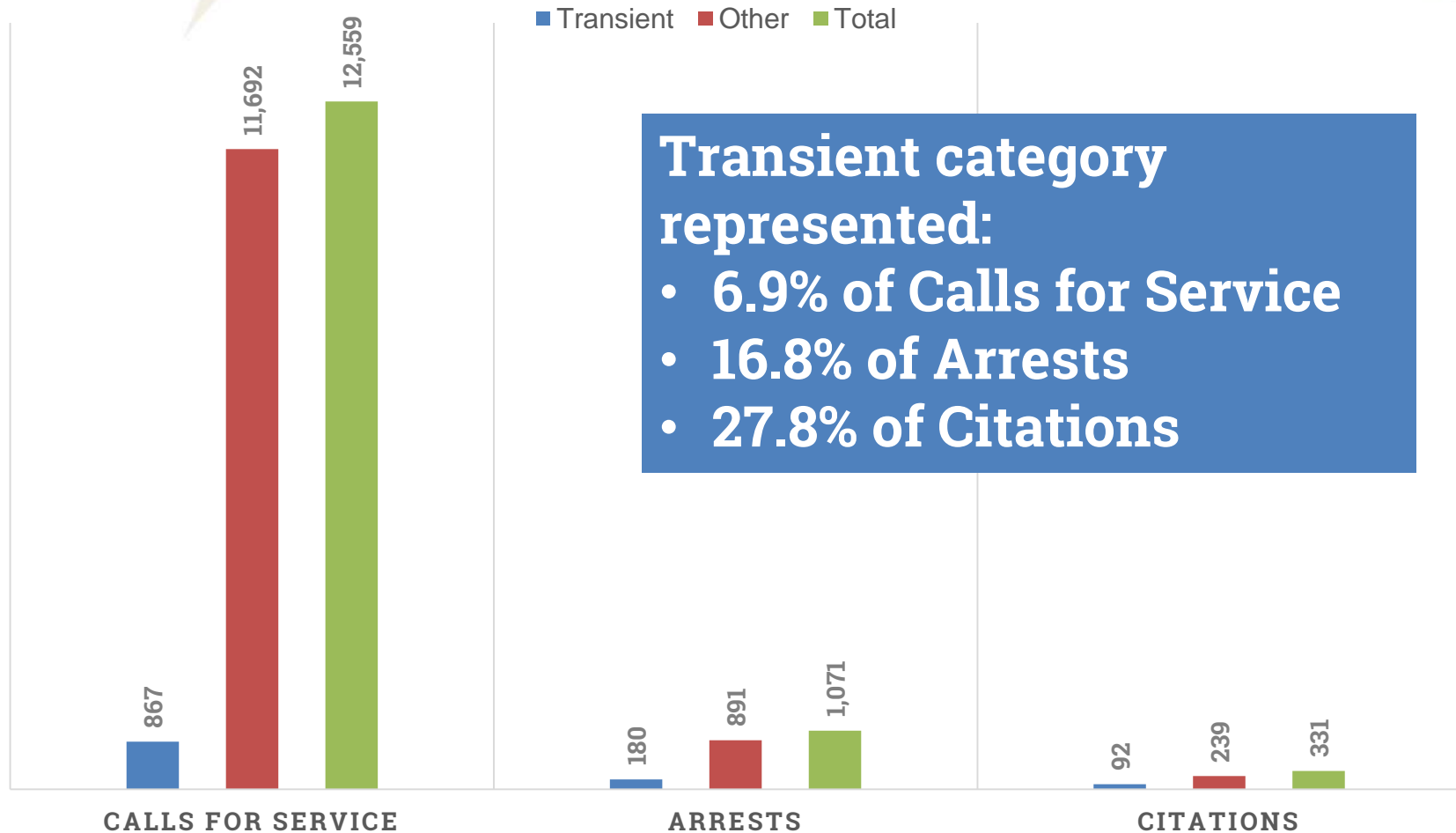
Activities in Lincoln Park and Other Areas

Immediate Actions



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- **Increase security presence in downtown**
- **Collaborate with partners to increase surveillance**
- **Work with judicial system on mandatory jail sentences for repeat offenders**
- **Team with parole to monitor and work with transient parolees**
- **Provide liquor store education on habitual offenders and re-education of liquor laws**

Mental Health & Homelessness



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- **Partnered with North Range Behavioral Health to provide two additional co-responders**
- **Increased availability of co-responders to respond to calls involving mental health**



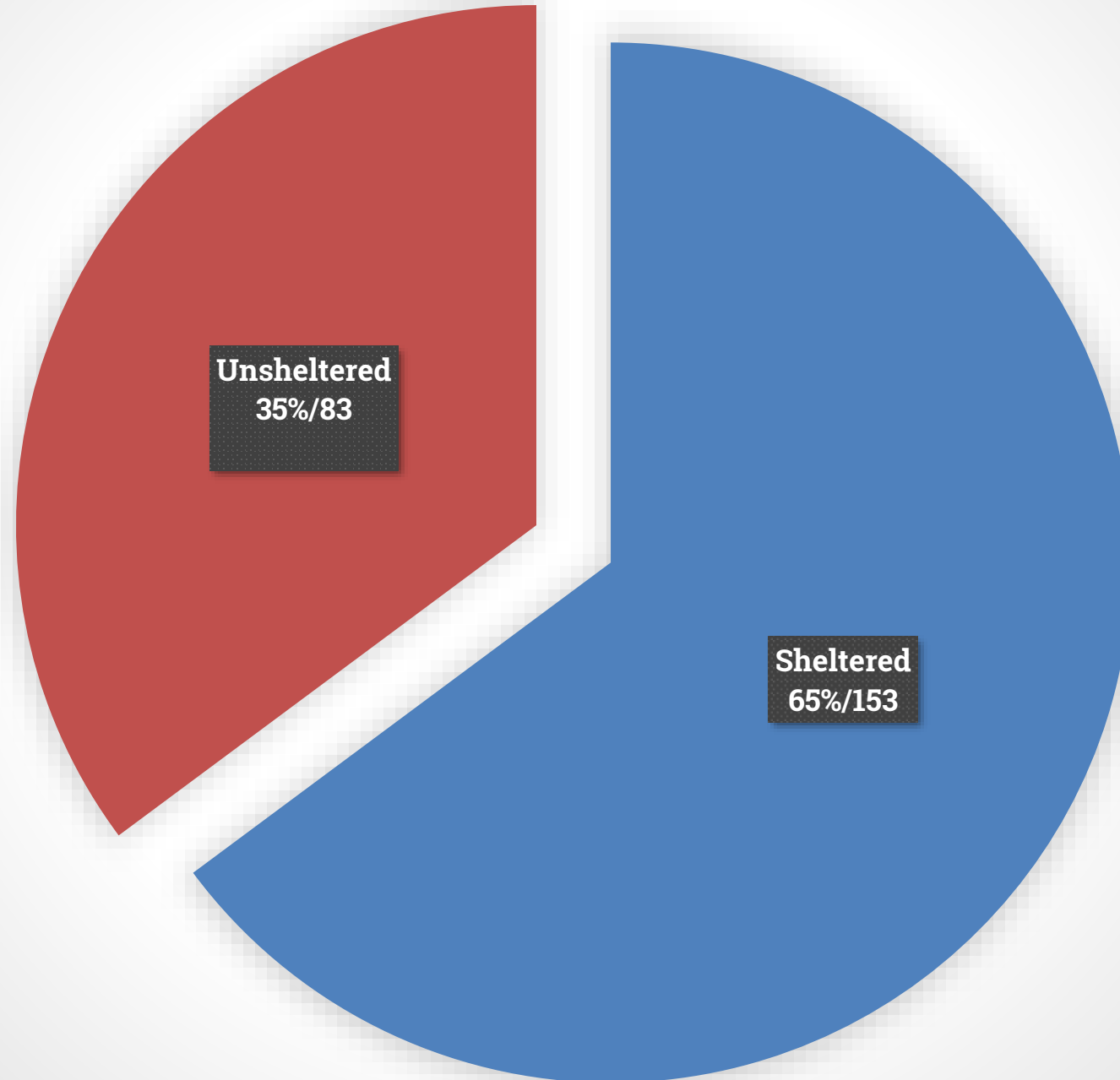
Co-responders can follow up with citizens suffering mental health issues to both reduce the number of 911 calls and risk of injury to citizens and officers

Current Sheltering Options



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- **Total Emergency Shelter Beds in Winter: 138**
- **Total Emergency Shelter Beds outside winter months: 62**
- **Currently do not have enough shelter beds even during winter to meet the need**

Day Center

- **No Year-round**

Full-Service Team

- **No full service intensive case management team**

Feedback from Interviews



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- **Most who experience homelessness desire:**
 - **Housing**
 - **A place to be during the *day and night***
 - **More Shelters**
 - **Help to get housing**
 - **Safety- ability to keep their person and possessions safe**
 - **More treatment options for mental health and substance use**
