Downtown: Safe and Secure Community and Housing for All

Background:

During the September 6, 2022 City Council meeting, a number of Downtown Greeley residents and business owners spoke during the public comment period to express concerns pertaining to two of the City Council Strategic Priority areas related to the downtown: Safe and Secure Community and Housing for All. The two prevailing themes of the residents and business community feedback were:

- 1. increased criminal activity in the downtown area; and
- 2. increased number of persons experiencing homelessness in the downtown area

Those who spoke during the public comment period shared the negative impacts these issues have on both the quality of life and economic vitality of the downtown area.
