
2023 Budget Council Timeline






2023 Forecasted Revenue*

2023 Proposed Budget Expenditures: Council Priorities








Utility Rate Changes

Average Monthly Bill Estimate – Single Family




Regional Water Bill Comparison

Regional Sewer Bill Comparison


