The Director will provide the Water & Sewer Board with a brief update on the following items of interest

1. City of Greeley and Water Industry Events
  - a. CWCB Drought Summit - 5/31 & 6/1 (currently a wait list)
  - b. Summer Board & Council Tour – July 28, 2023
    - i. Tentative: Chimney Hollow Res. Construction, Boyd Lake WTP, Terry Ranch Pipeline Construction, 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave. Reservoirs and Wastewater Treatment Facility
  - c. Tour of Greeley's Bob Creek Diversion from Upper Laramie into Poudre - TBD
  - d. Colorado Water Congress Conference – August 2023 dates TBD
2. Greeley Water Treatment Source Water Quality Disruptions Update
  - a. Periodic wildfire sediment and debris in the Poudre River; While infrequent, events have caused shut down of the Poudre River diversion intake
    - i. NPIC / NCWCD trade in place, but exchange must be in priority
  - b. Recent mud/soil slide into Charles Hanson Canal between Horsetooth North Outlet and Bellvue WTP caused a lot of high turbidity muddy water to enter the Bellvue settling ponds
  - c. The water system and the operations team continue to show resiliency, and customer should not expect any change to their treated water quality.
  - d. Boyd Lake WTP seasonal treatment plant start up and demand management
