



Aerial perspective – looking Northeast










- * BUMP OUT INTERSECTION CORNERS TO SUPPORT PEDESTRIAN MOVEMENTS



INCREASE AREA PARKING

- * CONVERT 9TH AVENUE PARALLEL PARKING TO DIAGONAL PARKING BETWEEN 15TH & 17TH STREETS
- * ACQUIRE/COLLABORATE ON NEW POCKET PARKING AREAS ON PRIVATE, UNDERUTILIZED LOTS


