Options presented

- Option 1 Permissible fireworks remain legal
- Option 2 Modify existing ordinance
 - Increase fines
 - Consideration of a social host ordinance
- Option 3 Prohibit all fireworks



Municipal Fines & Surcharge

| City | Current Fines | Notes |
|-------------|--------------------------------|---|
| Greeley | \$150 + \$30 surcharge = \$180 | For subsequent violations, officer discretion to issue citation/fine or summons only into court |
| Ft. Collins | \$1,000-\$3,000 | Summons only with possibility of up to 6 months in jail |
| Longmont | fines range up to \$999 | Summons only with possibility of up to 18 months in jail |
| Loveland | \$1,000 | If the defendant cannot pay immediately, sentenced to 3 days in county jail |
| Thornton | \$500-\$1,000 | Summons only |

Code Revision – Chapter 15

- Sec 14-482 Knowingly provide private property for possession or use of illegal fireworks.
 - No one who owns, rents, leases or controls private property shall knowingly allow any person to possess or use fireworks, except for permissible fireworks as allowed in sec 14-481, anywhere on said property.



Code Revision – Chapter 15

- Sec 14-483 Penalty.
 - Changed from a misdemeanor infraction to a <u>misdemeanor offense</u>
 - Fine increase from \$500.00 to <u>not less than \$1000.00</u>, <u>plus any additional</u> <u>penalties assessed.</u>
 - <u>Up to \$500.00 of the fine on a first violation may be suspended if the guilty party completes a city-sponsored or city-approved fire safety course, within 91 days of sentencing.</u>
 - A repeat violation within 365 days from a finding of guilty shall cause the full amount of the fine to be immediately reinstated in full.



Recommendation

Council's recommended action is to adopt the ordinance and publish with reference to title only.
