Background

- On May 19, 2021 the Greeley Water and Sewer Board approved a purchase and sale agreement with Longs Peak Dairy for acquisition of 5 1/6 shares of Water Supply and Storage Company (WSSC)
 - WSSC is the number one target for the city's acquisition program
 - Agreement included a land trade



Background


- Proposed sale of two properties (Hasbrouck and Varra farms) to Longs Peak Dairy
 - Farms are valued at approximately \$2,000,000
 - Sale reduces cash outlay for WSSC purchase
 - Water and Sewer Board recommended to City Council to approve divestment



Hasbrouck & Varra Farms

- Hasbrouck Farm:
 - o 282 +/- acres
 - \$1,100,000

- Varra Farm:
 - 156 +/- acres
 - 。\$900,000



Farm Divestment

- Longs Peak Dairy will continue to use the farms for agriculture
- Buyer Pays for diligence, no brokerage
- City obtains dry-up and revegetation covenants
- Leaseback for both farms
 - 10 year primary lease of water rights
 - Lease may be extended for up to 5, 1-year terms



Recommended Action

Staff recommends introducing the ordinance and scheduling a public hearing and final reading for July 6, 2021
