COMMUNITY POLICING EVENTS

- Community Policing Deputies conducted a District tour with Liberty Elementary on Tuesday 02/10 and Wednesday 02/11.
- Community Policing Deputies met with a foster youth for mentoring, provided lunch and transported her to school.
- Community Policing Deputies assisted a Pickwick family in need with baby formula and diapers.
- Girls Who Code
- Community Policing Deputies hosted a Career Day at Potentia Academy for autistic children. The PBSO Mounted Unit, SWAT Unit, Marine Unit, Therapy Dog Unit, and Road Patrol assisted with the event. The turnout was successful.
- Community Policing Deputies went to Target to meet with a volunteer regarding the start of "Stroll with a Deputy" and upcoming event planning.

STREET CRIMES UNIT


- **C/N 26-031009** – While on proactive patrol District 16 Street Crime Unit attempted a traffic stop on a silver Nissan SUV for a traffic violation. The vehicle failed to yield, and the initial stop was terminated. Agents continued monitoring the vehicle undetected until it came to a complete stop at an intersection, where an open-air takedown was conducted. The subject was found in possession of a loaded Glock 27 and was confirmed to be a convicted felon. The subject was arrested for Felon in Possession of a Firearm and Fleeing/Eluding Law Enforcement.
- **C/N 26-032820 / 26-032845 / 26-032844** – District 16 Street Crime Unit and District 16 Community Policing conducted surveillance and observed a hand-to-hand transaction. District 16 Street Crime Unit followed the dealer's vehicle and attempted a traffic stop for a violation. The vehicle refused to stop and fled at a high rate of speed. District 16 Community Policing Deputies contacted the buyers and conducted an investigative stop. Agents have pending charges on the suspect for possession of cocaine with intent to sell within 1,000 feet of a church, possession of fentanyl, transportation of paraphernalia, possession of paraphernalia, and unlawful use of a two-way communication device (case is pending chemistry report). Agents arrested the suspect for possession of cocaine. The suspect was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail and charged accordingly.
- **C/N 25-087828** – Agents obtained an arrest warrant for the suspect for Flee and Elude. Agents conducted a thorough background and surveillance was established at 3210 N. Jog Rd, Apt. 2102 West Palm Beach FL. Agents observed the subject at the residence and with the assistance of Warrants Division contact was made with the subject and he was taken into custody without incident. The suspect was transported to the Palm Beach County and charged accordingly.
- **C/N 26-032845** - District 16 Street Crime Unit located a suspect in reference to the Agent's probable cause for possession of cocaine with intent to sell within 1,000 feet of a church, possession of fentanyl, transportation of paraphernalia, possession of drug paraphernalia, and unlawful use of a two-way communication device. The suspect was transported to Palm Beach County Jail.

PROPERTY DETECTIVES


- **C/N 25-095974** – On September 24th, 2025 the SFCAT apprehended four suspects and got an arrest warrant for the fifth outstanding suspect that were responsible for several business burglaries where the suspects target ATMs and safes. The suspects were interviewed, several phones and vehicles were recovered, and several residential search warrants were executed. While reviewing the results of the phone dump extractions for one of the suspects, the suspect’s probable cause was also established.
- **C/N 26-027754** - On January 24th, 2026 the All about Smoke store was burglarized and a suspect vehicle was identified. The suspects changed vehicles and then burglarized two stores in District 9 on January 28th, 2026. Detectives partnered with agencies in Broward and surveillance was conducted on a known vape store burglary crew. During surveillance suspects committed another burglary in Broward County. Three suspects were apprehended, their phones were recovered, and residential search warrants were conducted at their residences. High dollar amount worth of vapes were recovered and the clothing worn during the burglaries. Search Warrants were obtained for the suspect’s cell sites and extraction. A TICO was obtained for the suspect who was extradited from the Broward JAC to the Palm Beach County JAC on February 20th, 2026.

DATA ANALYSIS


