STREET CRIMES UNIT

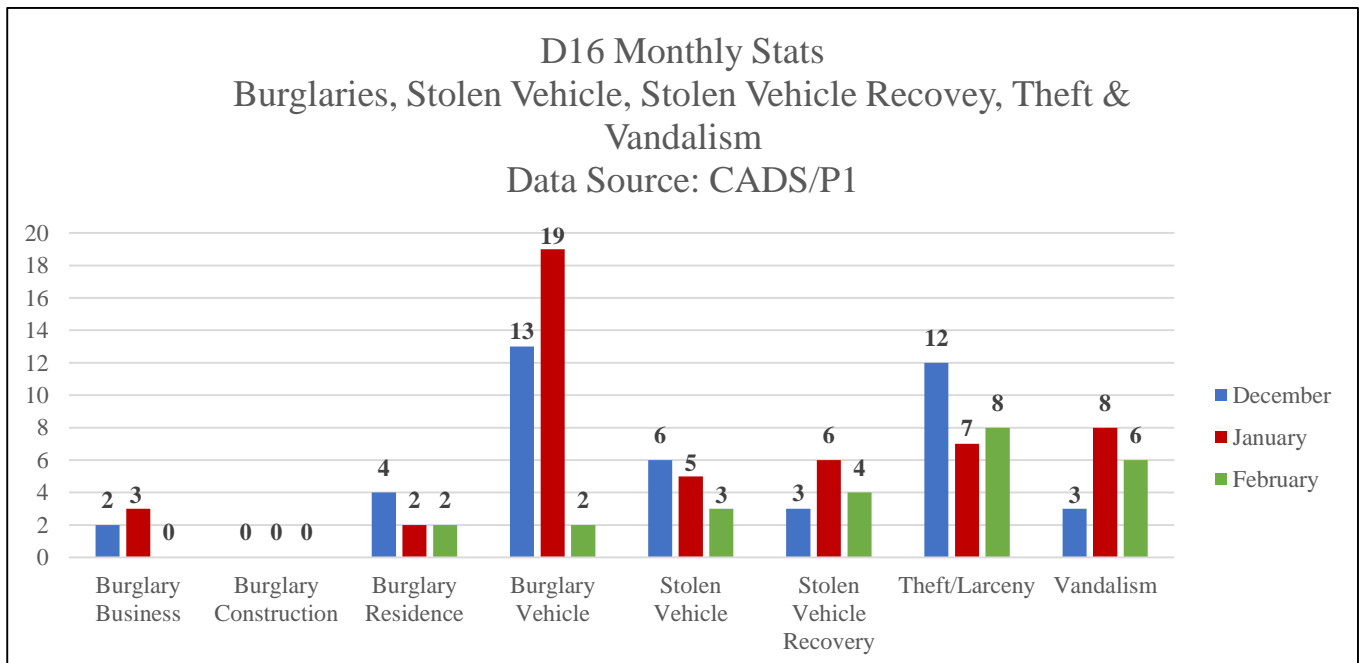
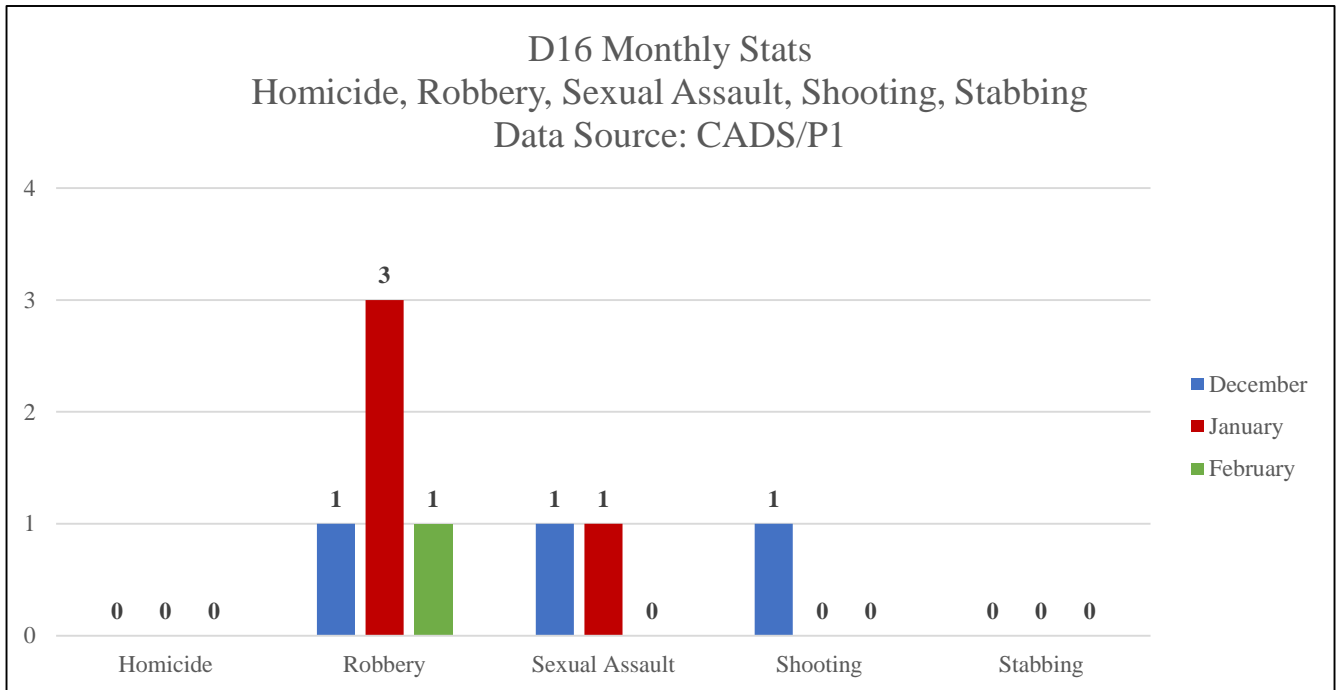
- The District 16 Street Crimes Unit conducted a traffic stop due to the driver being identified as having an active US Marshalls warrant for trafficking methamphetamine. The warrant was confirmed and the suspect was charged accordingly.
- The District 16 Street Crimes Unit conducted a traffic stop. Probable cause to search the vehicle was established and a firearm, 7.2g crack cocaine, and .2g marijuana were discovered. The driver was charged accordingly.
- The District 16 Street Crimes Unit had probable cause to arrest a suspect for multiple armed robberies in District 16 and District 1. The suspect was located. Upon arrest the suspect was found to be in possession of fentanyl and xanax. The suspect was charged accordingly.

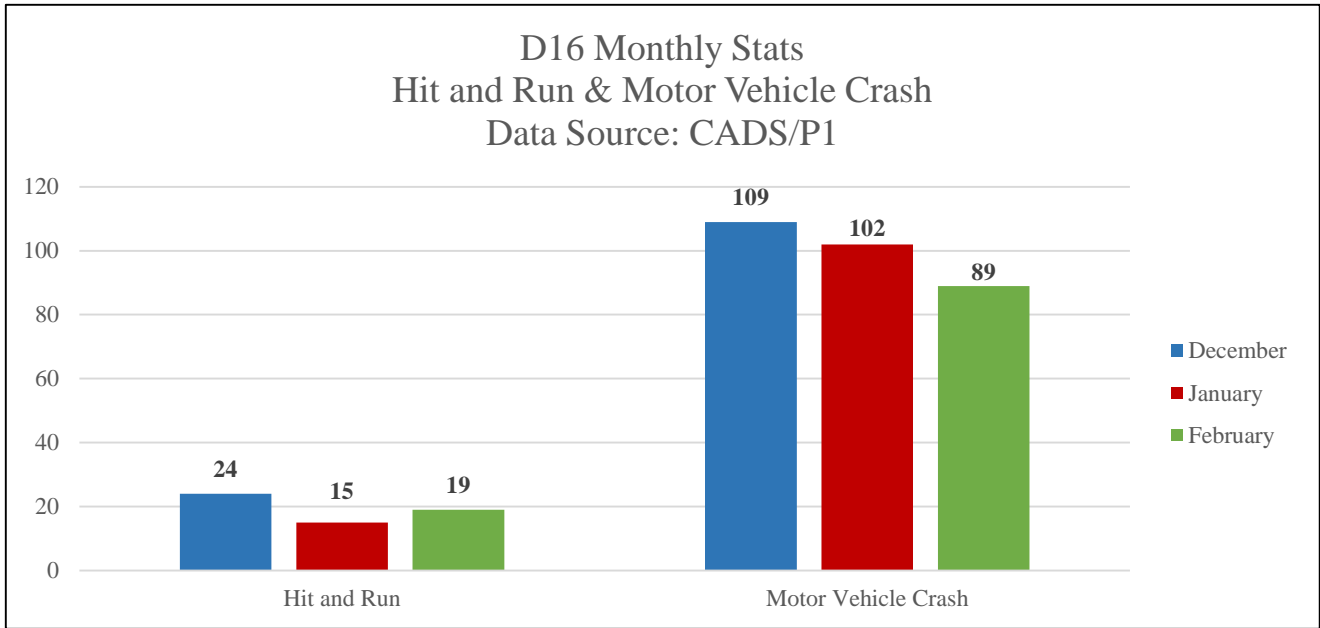
PROPERTY DETECTIVES

- A shoplifting incident occurred a business located in the city for a total of \$1,200.00. Two suspects were identified located, and apprehended. This case was cleared by arrest.
- A residential burglary occurred where the suspect stole a package off the victim's enclosed patio. That same evening, a suspect matching the suspect's description was peeping in windows and exposing himself to other residents in the neighborhood. Detectives were able to identify the suspect and executing a residential search warrant at the suspects residence. During the search warrant, the stolen property along with all clothing worn during the crimes were recovered. Additionally, the suspect confessed to the crimes and this case was cleared by arrest.
- District 16 Detectives were actively working a stolen vehicle which occurred within the City of Greenacres. The vehicle was later recovered, the vehicle was processed for latent prints, and a suspect was identified. The suspect was and transported to the JAC. This case was cleared by arrest.

DATA ANALYSIS

The data included in this report is charted and graphed to illustrate and compare changes over a specific time period. These charts and graphs are utilized to assist in determining crime trends and to measure enforcement efforts. This data is utilized in conjunction with other analysis to develop directed patrol and various enforcement activities.
