## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-09**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENACRES, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE PALM BEACH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SUSTAINABILITY FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING FOR FY 2022-2023, FOR AN INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT IN THE CITY'S ORIGINAL SECTION; AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County on June 5, 2017, for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program to qualify for appropriations in Federal Fiscal Years 2021, 2022, and 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has identified the Original Section of the City as a target area eligible for authorized Community Development Block Grant activities; and

WHEREAS, it was determined there is a need for infrastructure development within the Original Section of the City that improves the quality of life for the residents within the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that this project has priority and is consistent with all relevant sections of the City's adopted Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENACRES, FLORIDA, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council grants authorization for the submittal of the application to the Palm Beach County Department of Economic Sustainability for FY 2021-2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for the Phase 8 of the Stormwater Drainage Enhancement Project in the Original Section of the City of Greenacres.

**SECTION 2.** The City authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute and submit all documents for the 2022-2023 Community Development Block Grant Application.
