SUBJECT: Public Works Department Report

DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Listed below is a brief summary of the activities undertaken by the Public Works Department during the period of December 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

1. ADMINISTRATION:

- Entry gates at Veterans Park were replaced.
- Staff met with contractors for the City Hall upgrades and developed a timeline to for the project.
- All Staff participated in an interactive Team Building Course and The Sunshine 811 Call Training.
- Submitted annual Tree City USA re-certification.

2. ROADS AND DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE

- Over 50% of the street signs in the Original Section of the City have been reinforced with new decorative brackets for better endurance and durability.
- A 10' section of damaged sidewalks was replaced on Gladiator Circle.

3. VEHICLE MAINTENANCE

- New smart tablet mounts were installed in Fire Rescue trucks.
- Completed the installation of the new Holmatro (aka the jaws of life) in Ladder 95.
- Staff participated in automotive training "*Intermittent Electrical & Drivability Diagnostic Strategies*".

4. BUILDING SERVICES

- Staff assisted with set up preparations for the Holiday in the Park event.
- The exterior of the City Hall Building was inspected for obstructions prior to painting, including shrub removal and tree trimming for better access.

5. PARKS MAINTENANCE

- Staff assisted with set up preparations for the Holiday in the Park event.
 - Construction of the volleyball courts at Freedom Park is approximately 90% complete.
 - Land area cleared at Freedom Park was re-sodded.
