#### STREET CRIMES UNIT

- The District 16 Street Crimes Unit was requested to assist PBSO VCD Homicide Detectives with locating a suspect on charges related to a homicide investigation and several outstanding warrants. The suspect was located and taken into custody without incident.
- The District 16 Street Crimes Unit assisted PBSO Gang Unit with locating and apprehending a suspect for outstanding charges related to a recent homicide.
- The District 16 Street Crimes Unit assisted PBSO Gang Unit with locating and apprehending a suspect for outstanding charges related several aggravated assaults with a firearm.
- The District 16 Street Crimes Unit and Detective Bureau located a suspect during an auto theft investigation. The suspect was located driving the stolen vehicle, taken into custody without incident, and charged accordingly.


#### PROPERTY DETECTIVES


- District 16 Detective Bureau Total Monthly Stats for December 2021:

- The District 16 Detectives investigated a series of vehicle burglaries that occurred in the city. During the investigation, one suspect was identified after making a fraudulent purchase and was later arrested by Delray Beach Police Department. This suspect was arrested with another suspect who was found to be in possession of one of the victims' stolen firearm. Detectives responded and both suspects confessed to committing the burglaries and the cases were cleared by arrest.
- The District 16 Detectives investigated an incident of Aggravated Assault Firearm where a suspect pointed a firearm at a Greenacres Parks attendant. Through further investigation, the suspect was positively identified and apprehended by the District 16 Street Crimes Unit. During a recorded interview, the suspect confessed to detectives. The gun was located and later proven to be a BB gun. This case was cleared by arrest.
- The District 16 Detectives responded to a scene and reviewed surveillance footage along with interviewing the victim. A suspect was identified and probable cause was established. The suspect was charged with burglary to a vehicle and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail.


District 16 Road Patrol responded to a burglary to a vehicle in-progress where one suspect was apprehended with a large amount of stolen property. Detectives responded to the scene and the property recovered was identified by the victim. The vehicle was processed and surveillance footage placed into evidence. The suspect was charged with burglary to a vehicle and petit theft.
