SUBJECT: City Council approval of **Final** Invoice 21-101 in the amount of \$80,513.00 to Essential Painting Incorporated (EPI) for tank painting at all water and wastewater facilities, piggybacking on University of Florida Bid # 20B334 for wastewater facility painting.

BACKGROUND

Tankage at all water and wastewater facilities were in need of painting. The water facilities had not been painted in over 10 years.

With the construction of the new wastewater treatment plant approaching, upon completion the existing tanks that remain will be painted to complement the new construction. Upon completion of the new plant the entire facility will be freshly painted and landscaped providing a professional appearance.

Staff solicited quotes from Utility Service Company (USC) which has the current long-term contract for painting the city's elevated storage tanks (water towers) and EPI who has a contract with the University of Florida upon which we can "piggyback".

On 10/20/2020 Council approved a task order with EPI in the amount of \$80,513.00 to paint the city's water and wastewater facilities.

FISCAL IMPACT

\$80,513.00 from the Water and Wastewater CIP Budgets.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve Invoice 21-101 in the amount of \$80,513.00 to Essential Painting Incorporated for tank painting at all water and wastewater facilities, piggybacking on University of Florida Bid # 20B334 for wastewater facility painting.
