

RESOLUTION NO. R-21-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN COVE SPRINGS, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE 2022 CLAY COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, assigns to the Board of Clay Commissioners responsibility for disaster preparedness, response, recovery and mitigation; and

WHEREAS, being prepared for disasters means being ready to respond promptly as danger threatens, to save life and protect property and to provide relief from suffering and privation; and

WHEREAS, local services may be overburdened or inadequate and local government will have to operate effectively in different ways than in normal times to provide timely relief and minimize hardships in the event of natural and technological disasters in the Clay County; and

WHEREAS, many populated areas and parts of communities may require evacuation, shelter and food until the disaster ends, services are restored and needed supplies and materials are available; and

WHEREAS, this plan is intended to provide the framework for the development of detailed operating procedures for all forces charged with the responsibility of protecting the public's health and safety from natural and technological disaster; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 27P-6, Florida Administrative Code, requires each County to develop a Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 27P-6, Florida Administrative Code, furthermore, requires the governing body of the Clay County to adopt by resolution, the Clay County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN COVE SPRINGS, FLORIDA, THAT THE CLAY COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN IS HEREBY ACCEPTED.
