

## **RESOLUTION NO. R-02-2023**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN COVE SPRINGS, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE PERSONNEL POLICY MANUAL, DESIGNATING JUNE 19TH AS A HOLIDAY, AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Personnel Policy Manual Section 12.1 specifies the days observed as legal holidays for the City of Green Cove Springs; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 17, 2021, President Joe Biden signed into law a bill declaring June 19<sup>th</sup> as, “Juneteenth National Independence Day,” and declaring such a legal public holiday; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to add a legal holiday on June 19<sup>th</sup> as “Juneteenth National Independence Day.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN COVE SPRINGS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The legal holidays observed by the City of Green Cove Springs are hereby scheduled according to Exhibit “A” attached hereto.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
