Rate Call

The average price of natural gas for the month was \$3.54. Natural gas prices have been in the \$3.01-3.67 range over the last thirty day. With the recently adjusted gas stabilization targets, positions were added and 43% of natural gas usage for FY26 is stabilized. Positions in FY27 (10%) and FY28 (5) have been established.

Natural gas accounted for 86% of the generation mix. Coal was 7%; nuclear was 4%. Solar generation was 2%.

The peak for the month was 17 June at 5PM.

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors approved Resolutions of appreciation for Barbara Quñones and Howard McKinnon. Annual election for Board Officers was held. Allan Putnam (Jacksonville Beach) was elected as Chair, Bob Page (Green Cove Springs) as Vice Chair, Ed Liberty (Lake Worth Beach) as Treasurer and Lynne Tejeda (Key West) as Secretary.

Fifteen members of FMPA received a combined total of 29 reliability awards. The award categories are Leadership (lowest annual average outage duration), Momentum (largest annual average outage duration reduction percentage), Endurance (consecutive years with an annual average outage duration of 60 minutes or less) and Duration Improvement (annual average outage duration improvement equal or greater than 10%)

Information items covering social media and communications were deferred to the August meeting.

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee elected officers for the up coming year; Javier Cisneros (Fort Pierce) as Chair and Bob Page (Green Cove Springs) as Vice Chair.

The information item covered excess power sales.

Policy Makers Liaison Committee

The committee elected officers for the coming year. Bob Page (Green Cove Springs) and Jim Hilty, Sr. (Ocala) were elected as Chair and Vice Chair respectively.

Jacob Williams provided a year-to-date FMPA scorecard update and Navid Nowakhtar reviewed industry reliability.

FMEA Annual Conference

The conference covered data centers, rating agency outlook for the industry, cyber readiness, recent history of Gainesville Regional Utility happenings, Federal government update, customer service strategies, Muni fiber challenges and a roadmap for successful grid modernization. The keynote speaker was Robert Bryce who covered renewables, hydrocarbons, nuclear and the future of US electricity demand.
