SUBJECT: First Public Hearing on the Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Annual Operating Budget and approval

of Resolution No. R-21-2025 adopting the Tentative Annual Operating Budget for Fiscal

Year 2025/2026 and set September 16, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. as the final hearing date.

BACKGROUND

The second issue to be discussed at the City of Green Cove Springs public hearing on the millage rate and the budget is the tentative Annual Operating Budget. At all public hearings, the Council shall hear comments regarding the budget and citizens shall be allowed to speak and ask questions prior to the adoption of any measures by the Council. The total proposed operating budget released at the August 7, 2025 budget workshop for the City of Green Cove Springs for Fiscal Year 2026 is \$61,498,350, which is \$3,274,562 less than Fiscal Year 2025.

Since the budget workshop, staff have identified the following changes to General Fund budget:

Staff have decided not to pursue the two FRDAP grants in Fiscal Year 2026. There is no budget impact as capital expenditures are reduced by \$200,000, and the budgeted grant revenue is also reduced by \$200,000. Adjustments to other funds include increasing stormwater fee for Wastewater fund (\$17,404) and Stormwater Fund (\$252) and increasing salary to Customer Service Fund (\$26,876) to bring these items in line with FY2025 projections.

Also included in the proposed budget is the second half of 50th percentile adjustment and 2.3% COLA increases. The table below summarizes the impact on each fund:

The revenue sources identified in General Fund to pay for the payroll increases referenced above are \$150,000 increase to red light camera revenue (to bring the original budgeted amount in line with FY25 projection) and \$400,000 projected revenue associated with the speed enforcement efforts in the school zones in the City. The payroll increases in other funds are absorbed by each fund's fund balance.

The attached Budget By Fund Type to Resolution No. R-21-2025 reflects the original budget as presented on August 7, 2025 and the adjustments to the budget referenced above. Total proposed operating budget for the City of Green Cove Springs for Fiscal Year 2026 is \$61,806,115, which is \$2,966,797 less than Fiscal Year 2025.
