SUBJECT: Road improvements.

BACKGROUND

Staff is recommending that we use Duval asphalt off Clay County bid # 2020/2021-151 AM1 to pave/overlay Walnut St from East of the school board driveway at the parking lot to Pine St enter section. This part of Walnut St is the worst road the City owns and staff does highly recommend this project.

If Council decides to make this pavement look like brick later with stamping it would need to be milled at least an inch off and then repave a stamp. This is a very costly Process for the city which we are finding out in the downtown project as well.

This project would dramatically help this drive through the downtown area much smoother and look a lot better covering up holes, patch work and missing brick that have been removed over the years because of utility work or other reason unknown to us.

Also, approval of overlaying olive St for one block that was removed because of a drainage project done buy city staff replacing 300ft of 36' drainage pipe 8ft deep.
