COUNCIL BUSINESS

1. Establish Tentative Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2023/2024. *L. Steve Kennedy*City Manager Steve Kennedy speaks to the Council concerning the millage rate and budget for fiscal year 2023/2024. Mr. Kennedy advises the number in the budget is currently 5.000 mills which was used to get the DR420 form started. As the numbers stand, going from 4.500 mills to 5.000 will generated around \$340,000 more. Mr. Kennedy reminds the Council this is just to get the DR420 form completed, and the amount set can be reduced but if it is increased there will be additional steps that need completed.

Van Royal 3688 LaCosta Ct. GCS speaks to the Council about raising the millage. Mr. Royal advises insurance on homes is going up. If the number is raised to 5 mills it will be a 14% increase while increasing, it to 4.625 mills will only be 6 or 7 percent and he believes residents will be able to handle that increase along with the insurance increase. Mr. Royal speaks about improving the community, projects being completed, and looking into bringing on a grant writer. Council discussion followed concerning the millage rate.
