## Sec 90-378. - Hauled Wastes (Septage)

Septic tank waste may be accepted into the wastewater treatment facility at a designated receiving structure within the treatment plant area, at the discretion of and at such times as are established by the director, provided such wastes do not violate the provisions of Article VI, Sec 90-403 of this article or any other requirements established by the city. Wastewater discharge permits for individual vehicles to use such facilities shall be issued by and at the discretion of the director. At the sole discretion of the director, permits for Permittees that do not follow the established processes for discharging wastes into the facility will have their permit to discharge revoked.

The discharge of hauled industrial wastes as industrial septage requires prior approval and a wastewater discharge permit from the city. The director shall have authority to prohibit the disposal of such wastes, if such disposal would interfere with the treatment plant operation, in the director's sole judgement. Waste haulers are subject to all other sections of this article.

Fees for dumping septage will be established by the director and approved by the city council by ordinance or resolution.
